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I RAISED THIS WITH STANLEY TODAY AND HIS SHORT ANSWER WAS:
NO. WE DO NOT WANT TO EMBRACE THE CURRENT GOVERNMENT IN
THIS WAY AT THIS TIME. I KNOW THIS IS AWKWARD SO WE WILL
HAVE TO TEMPORIZE FOR NOW WITH OUR DEPLU FRIENDS AND, IF
THE GOVERNMENT BEGINS TO REESTABLISH ITS CREDIBILITY WITH
US, THEN TAKE THE ISSUE UP AGAIN WITH STANLEY WHEN THE
ATMOSPHERE IS MORE SUPPORTIVE.

## 2. (SBU) GSP

EB/TPP GAVE US A READOUT ON TODAY'S GSP MEETING AT USTR. ON THE ISSUE OF REDESIGNATION FOR CATEGORIES IN WHICH COUNTRIES HAVE EXCEEDED LIMITS, USTR IS RECOMMENDING

AGAINST REDESIGNATION FOR THE TOP TEN SOURCES OF GSP IMPORTS. THIS WOULD INCLUDE INDONESIA. AS WE PASSED ON EARLIER, USTR IS PREPARED TO SHOW MORE FLEXIBILITY IN GRANTING INDONESIA DE MINIMIS WAIVERS FOR EVERYTHING EXCEPT PLYWOOD. HOWEVER, LABOR WILL FIGHT THAT DECISION, AS WILL PARTS OF THE NSC. VIRGINIA WILL SIT DOWN WITH EBAND DRL ON TUESDAY TO MAKE A FIRST ATTEMPT AT HASHING OUT A STATE DEPARTMENT POSITION BEFORE USTR MEETS AGAIN ON THE ISSUE NEXT FRIDAY. EB IS SUPPORTIVE OF USTR'S VIEW ON THE DE MINIMIS WAIVERS WHILE DRL SUPPORTS LABOR'S POSITION.

## 3. (C) IMET/TRAINING

THE LAST PARAGRAPH OF THE USDAO CABLE REPORTING ON THE AMBASSADOR'S MEETING WITH GENERAL WIRANTO CAUGHT SOME PARTS CONFIDENTIAL

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OF THE DEPARTMENT BY SURPRISE. NOT EVERYBODY WAS AWARE OF
THE INDONESIAN INTENTION TO ACCEPT THE E-IMET TRAINING, AND
PLANS WERE BEING DRAWN UP TO ALLOCATE THE FUNDS TO OTHER
COUNTRIES. ANY FURTHER REPORTING YOU COULD PROVIDE EARLY
NEXT WEEK WILL BE HELPFUL.

WE ARE GETTING VIBES FROM THE HILL INDICATING THAT CONGRESS IS GREATLY DISPLEASED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION'S RESPONSE TO

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THE J-CET TRAINING ISSUE. WE MAY SEE FALLOUT IN THE FORM OF A CONGRESSIONAL RESTRICTION ON ALL JOINT TRAINING/EXERCISES WITH THE INDONESIAN MILITARY. DOD'S A/S KRAMER TESTIFIED LATE TODAY BEFORE THE SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE. STANLEY DIRECTED THAT WE NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE BRIEFING IN VIEW OF THE POTENTIAL DOWNSIDES. WE EXPECT THAT MONDAY'S BRIEFING FOR THE HIRC WILL BE ADJUSTED BASED ON A READOUT FROM TODAY'S SFRC MEETING.

#### 4. (SBU) ROTH VISIT

A/S STANLEY ROTH WILL BE IN THE REGION IN THE APRIL 6-20 TIMEFRAME. HE IS STRONGLY CONSIDERING A STOP IN JAKARTA APRIL 14-16 TO CALL ON NEW CABINET MINISTERS. I WILL TRY TO ACCOMPANY HIM IF POSSIBLE. WE WILL KEEP YOU UPDATED AS HIS SCHEDULE FIRMS UP. ALBRIGHT

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
